Leeman is a small coastal town in the Shire of Coorow in Western Australia and sits on turquoise waters, white sandy beaches and offshore islands harbouring a great diversity of marine life. The picturesque coastline offers great conditions for an array of water activities, such as windsurfing and sailing and fishing.

The town was named after Abraham Leeman van Santwits, a Dutch sailor. He was second officer on the <u>Dutch East India Company</u> ship <u>Vergulde Draeck</u> (*Gilt Dragon*) which was wrecked in April 1656 just south of <u>Ledge Point</u>,
